Examining what it may be like to have cognitive limitations. Exploring factors that may enhance the individual's confusion & disorientation.

- The Experience of Cognitive Limitations/Abilities
 - + Causes of impairment beyond Alzheimer's
 - + Factors contributing to the resident's confusion
 - + Seeing the world through the resident's eyes
 - + The range of symptoms and the degree of vulnerability

- The Proponents of Supportive Therapy
 - + Determining maximum functioning level
 - + Identifying strengths/compensating for limitations
 - + Dealing with challenging behaviours
 - + Reading behavioural cues to determine approach & intervention strategies
 - + Reality reinforcement in the environment and approach
 - + Utilizing effective communication strategies
